

## Entry Condition

1. Stochastic Indicator must have crossed or touched the specified levels of overbought or oversold.
2. After touching or crossing these zones, example if it crossed or touched the overbought zone and is facing downwards and is below the overbought level, a downward arrow is printed and alert sounded signaling a sell, and vice versa for an oversold zone.

Note in the above entry conditions, arrow and alert only pops up after the candle has closed on a specified time frame or time frames.

- KEY

- 1 – STOCH IS BELOW OVERBOUGHT LEVEL ON HIGHER TIME FRAME AND IS FACING DOWNWARDS
- 2 –STOCH IS BELOW OVERBOUGHT LEVEL ON LOWER TIME FRAME AND IS FACING DOWNWARDS
- 3 –SELL SIGNAL AND SELL ALERT
