Option while on automation trading another way, we can follow these by using indicator, which is better and easier

1 Limit Price -- - Offset 4 ticks. Profit target 10 ticks. Trailing stop..

2 Limit Price -- - Offset 8 ticks. Profit target 10 ticks

3 Limit Price -- - Offset 12 ticks. Profit target 10 ticks

1. AtmStrategyCreate()

- Purpose: Submits a new ATM entry order (Buy/Sell) directly from your chart panel.
- What it does in your bot:
- When you press Start Auto or Send Long/Short, it fires a limit order at the next bar open \pm offset.
- It attaches your chosen ATM template (with Profit Target, Stop Loss, and Trailing Stop rules).
- Result: You get an active trade with all risk brackets applied automatically.

3. CancelAllOrders()

- Purpose: Cancels only working (unfilled) entry orders, but does not flatten your current position.
- What it does in your bot:
- When you click Cancel Open Orders, it deletes pending limit/stop orders that haven't been filled yet.
- Very useful when automation re-issues orders every bar you can kill just the waiting orders without affecting your running trades.
- Result: Your current open trades remain active; only pending entries vanish.

2. AtmStrategyClose()

- Purpose: Closes/Flattens an open ATM-managed position.
- What it does in your bot:
- When you click Close All Positions, this command tells NinjaTrader to exit the trade, cancel targets/stops, and shut down that ATM instance.
- Result: You're instantly flat, with no leftover orders.

4. GetAtmStrategy... methods

- Purpose: Query and track the live status of an ATM strategy.
- What it does in your bot:
- Checks if your order got filled or is still pending.
- Confirms whether PT/SL orders are live.
- Ensures no duplicate ATM strategies get created (idempotency).
- Result: Reliable automation the bot knows if it should re-issue an order or not.

How These Fit Together in Your Panel?

You press Start Auto \rightarrow AtmStrategyCreate() fires the first order.
 Bot checks status with GetAtmStrategy...
 If order unfilled by bar close \rightarrow CancelAllOrders() \rightarrow new AtmStrategyCreate() on the next bar open.
 If you want to stop \rightarrow Stop Auto halts loop.
 If you want out \rightarrow Close All calls AtmStrategyClose().
