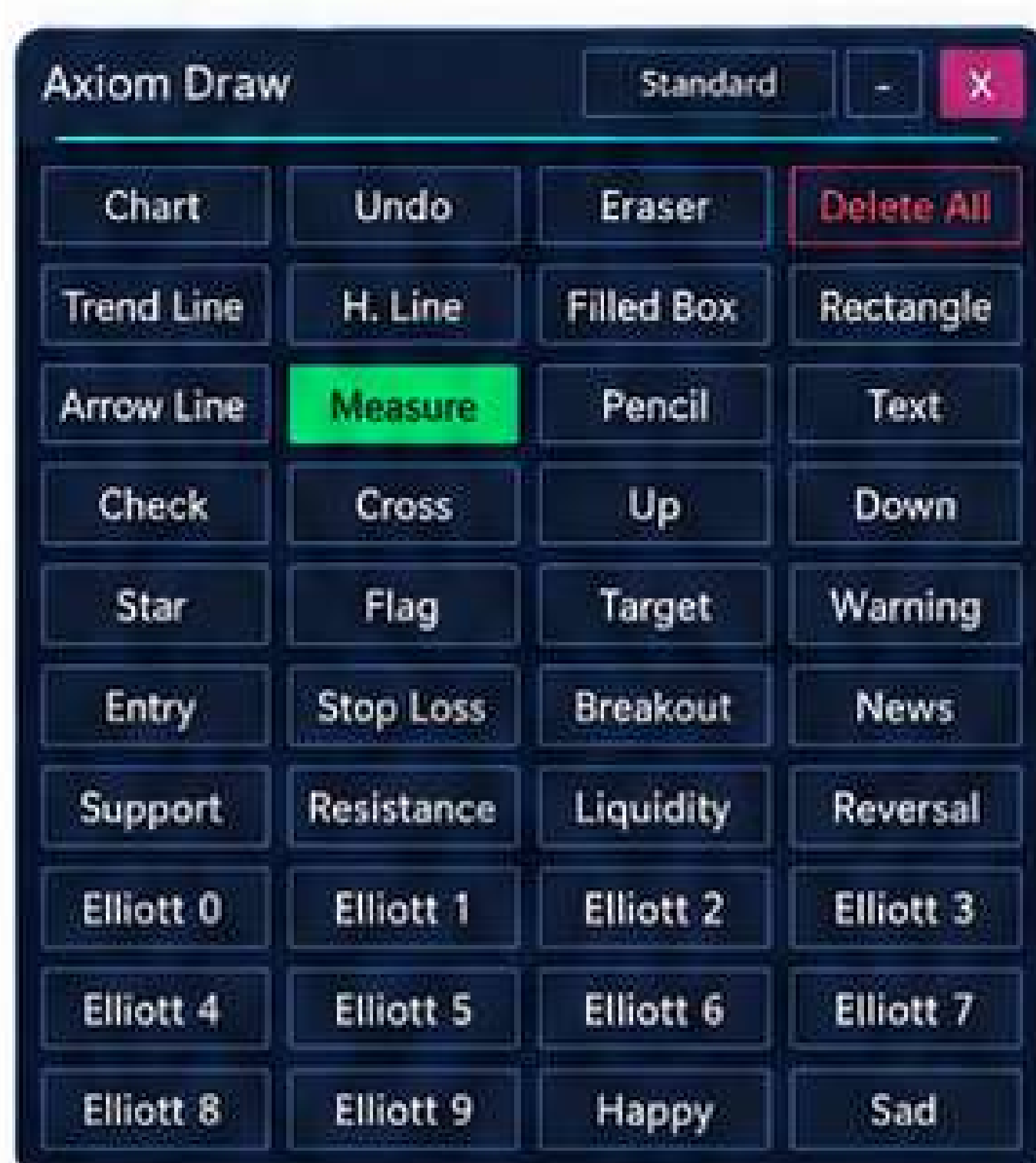

# Use Axiom Draw in 3 Simple Steps

Select a drawing tool, choose the visual style, then place your analysis directly on the chart.

## 01 · Choose Tool

Select what you want to place on the chart: a line, box, arrow, marker, label, text note or measurement.



## 02 · Choose Style

Pick the thickness and color before drawing, so your chart markings match the purpose of your analysis.



### 03 · Draw on Chart

Click, drag, or place the selected tool directly on the chart to build your visual analysis.



## Manual Visual Analysis

Axiom Draw does not decide the market direction for you. It gives you the tools to mark, measure, label and organize what you see on the chart.



### Quick Tip

Use Chart mode when you want to return to normal chart interaction after drawing.

# THE AXIOM DRAW PANEL

## Everything Organized in One Workspace

The panel groups drawing tools, chart markers, labels, colors and cleanup controls so you can build visual analysis faster.

### 01 Header Controls

Move the panel, switch layout mode, minimize the workspace or close Axiom Draw from the header area.

### 02 Main Controls

Use Chart to return to normal chart interaction, Undo to remove the last object, Eraser to remove one drawing, and Delete All to clean Axiom Draw drawings from the chart.

### 03 Core Drawing Tools

Use these tools to draw structure, zones, arrows, measurements, freehand notes and text directly on the chart.

### 04 Markers & Symbols

Add quick visual markers to highlight observations, confirmations, warnings or personal chart notes.

### Text Layout (Full)



Full text labels for maximum clarity and easy tool identification.

### Icon Layout (Compact)



Compact icon layout to save space while keeping all tools accessible.

### Collapsed Toolbar



Minimize the panel to a quick toolbar for a clean and focused workspace.

### 05 Trading Labels

Use trading labels to mark your own analysis areas. These labels do not decide the market direction automatically.

### 06 Elliott Labels

Place numbered Elliott labels when organizing wave counts or any numbered chart sequence.

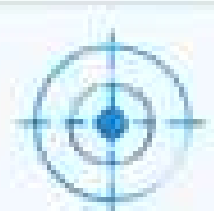
### 07 Thickness & Colors

Choose line thickness and color before drawing so each object matches its purpose on the chart.

### Panel Modes

Axiom Draw can display a fuller text layout or a compact icon-style layout. The header mode button lets you switch between layouts, while the minimize button reduces the panel into a quick toolbar.

**Tip:** The mode button shows the layout you can switch to next.



### REMEMBER:

Use **Chart** mode when you want to return to normal chart interaction after drawing.

# CORE DRAWING TOOLS

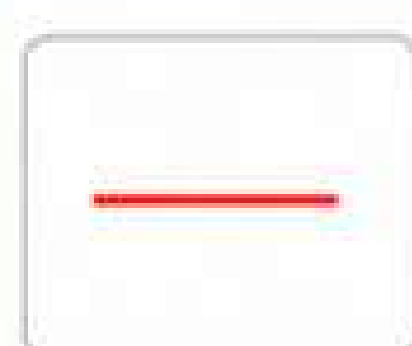
## Build Structure *Directly* on the Chart

Use lines, boxes, arrows, freehand drawing and text notes to organize your chart analysis visually.



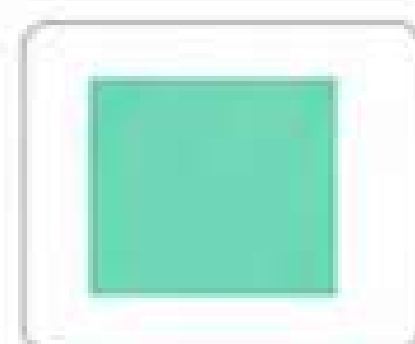
### 01 • Trend Line

Connect two points to visualize direction, trend structure, channels or angled levels.



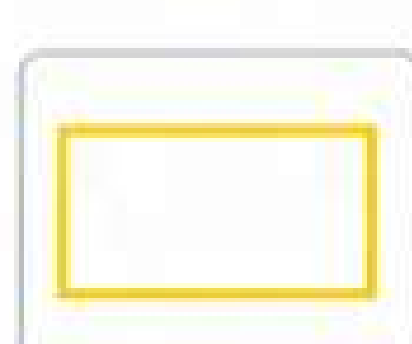
### 02 • H. Line

Place a horizontal reference level across the chart for prices, zones or important levels you want to watch.



### 03 • Filled Box

Highlight a zone with a filled area when you want the region to stand out clearly.



### 04 • Rectangle

Outline a chart area without fully covering the candles behind it.



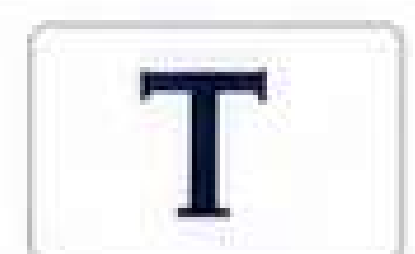
### 05 • Arrow Line

Draw a directional arrow to show movement, expected path, reaction or visual emphasis.



### 06 • Pencil

Use Pencil for freehand marking when a standard line or box is not enough.



### 07 • Text

Add written notes directly on the chart to explain your analysis in your own words.



## You Control the Drawing

AXIOM DRAW does not place these tools automatically.  
You select the tool, choose the style, and decide where the drawing belongs on the chart.

**Trend Line • H. Line • Filled Box • Rectangle • Arrow Line • Pencil • Text**

*Draw structure first. Then add labels, colors and markers to complete the analysis.*



# MARKERS & SYMBOLS

## Highlight Important Chart Observations

Use visual markers to draw attention to confirmations, warnings, reactions, targets or personal notes on the chart.

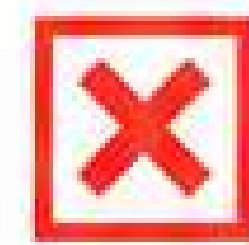


### 01 Confirmation & Rejection



#### 01 • Check

Mark confirmation, completion, approval or any positive observation you want to remember.



#### 02 • Cross

Mark invalidation, rejection, mistake, failed idea or an area you want to avoid.

### 02 Direction & Attention



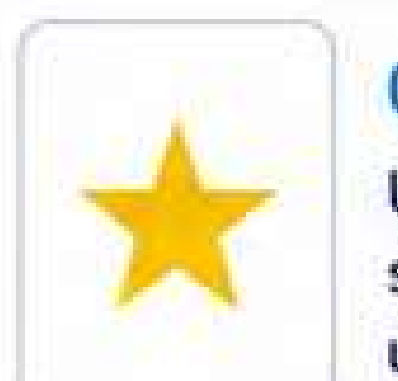
#### 03 • Up

Place an upward marker to highlight upward movement, reaction or directional interest.



#### 04 • Down

Place a downward marker to highlight downward movement, reaction or directional interest.



#### 05 • Star

Use Star to mark something important, unusual or worth reviewing later.



#### 06 • Flag

Use Flag to mark a reference point, setup area or important chart location.



#### 07 • Target

Use Target to identify a zone, point of interest or area you want to monitor.



#### 08 • Warning

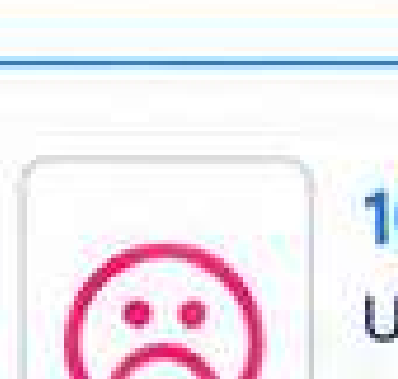
Use Warning to highlight risk, uncertainty, news impact or a chart area that needs attention.



### 03 Personal Notes

#### 09 • Happy

Use Happy as a personal positive marker for notes, reactions or useful observations.



#### 10 • Sad

Use Sad as a personal negative marker for notes, mistakes, caution or review points.



### You Decide the Meaning

Markers are visual notes. Axiom Draw does not automatically decide whether a marker means buy, sell, profit, loss or prediction. You place the symbol according to your own analysis.

Check • Cross • Up • Down • Star • Flag • Target • Warning • Happy • Sad

Use markers to make your chart easier to read at a glance.

# TRADING ANALYSIS LABELS

## Mark Your Own Trade Context Clearly

Use trading labels to identify the areas, levels and events that matter in your own chart analysis.



### TRADE PLANNING

#### 01 Entry

Mark a price, level or zone you consider relevant for a possible entry.

#### 02 Stop Loss

Mark the protective level, invalidation area or risk point you want to monitor.

### MARKET EVENTS

#### 03 Breakout

Label an area where you are watching or reviewing a breakout idea.

#### 04 News

Mark a chart area or time period connected to an important news event or reaction.

### KEY AREAS

#### 05 Support

Mark a support level or support zone identified from your own analysis.

#### 06 Resistance

Mark a resistance level or resistance zone you want to watch.

#### 07 Liquidity

Highlight a liquidity area, sweep zone or level you want to monitor.

#### 08 Reversal

Mark an area where you are watching for possible reversal behavior.



### LABELS ARE MANUAL ANNOTATIONS

These labels help you organize your own analysis. Axiom Draw does not decide the trade, predict the market or place labels automatically.

Use Elliott 0–9 labels to organize wave counts, chart sequences or numbered analysis points directly on the chart.

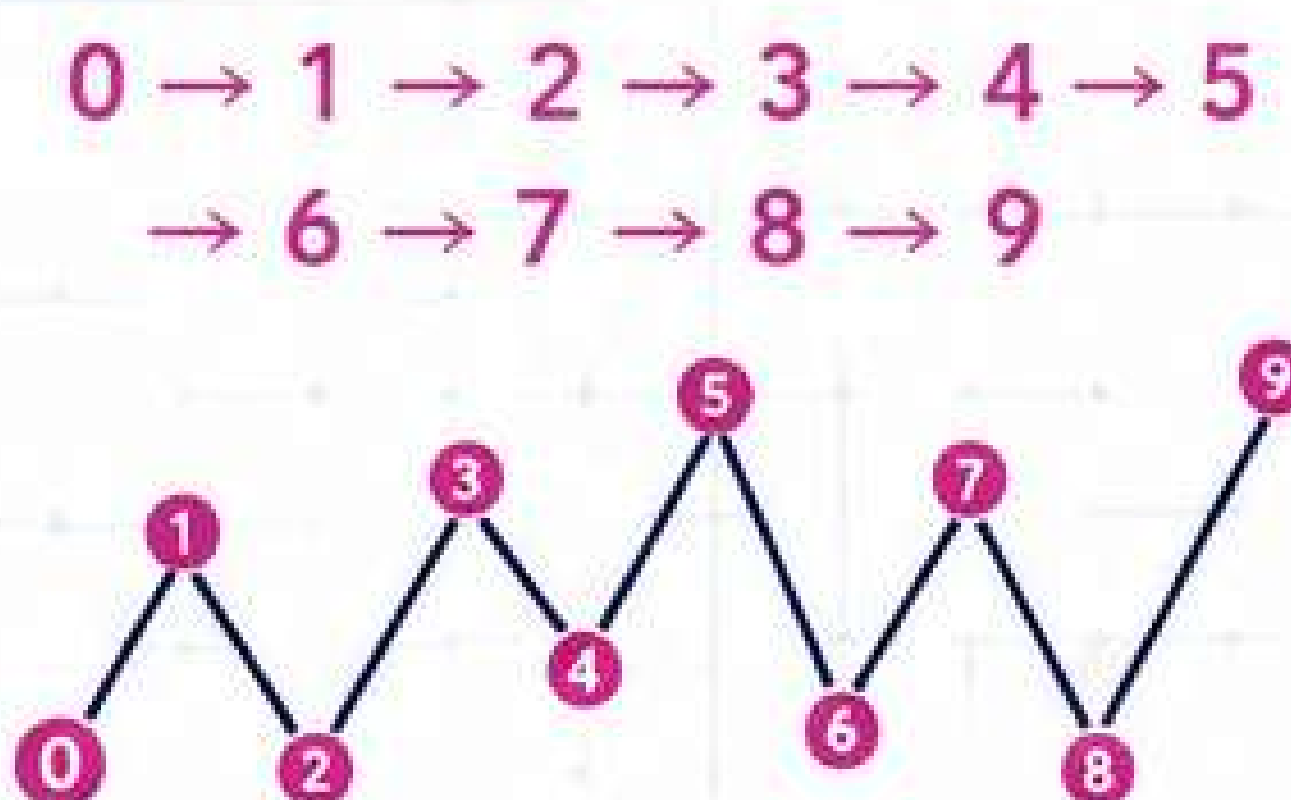

### 01 Elliott Label Buttons



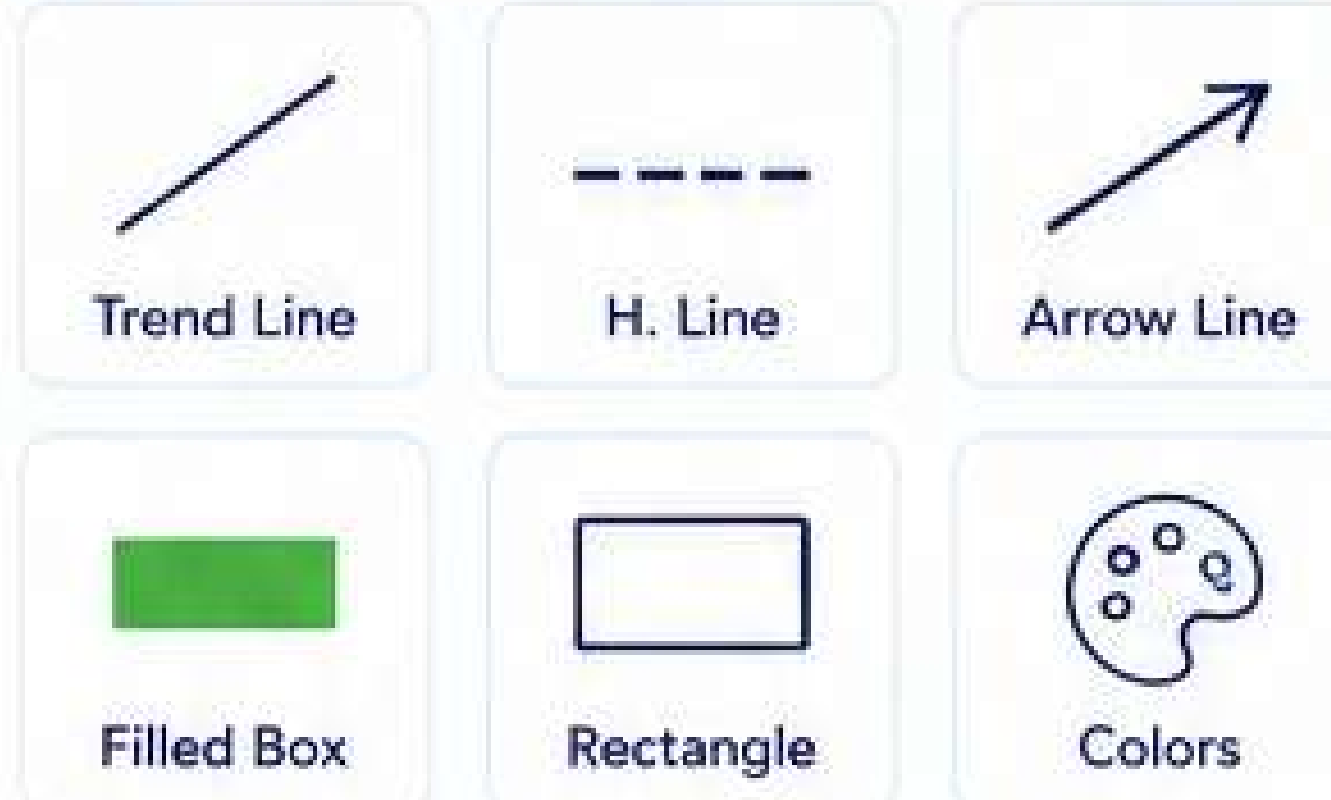
Select the number you want, then place it on the chart where it belongs in your wave or sequence analysis.

### 02 Build a Numbered Structure



Place each label at the point you want to identify, then continue building the sequence step by step.

### 03 Combine With Drawing Tools



Use Elliott labels together with drawing tools, boxes, lines, arrows and colors to make your wave structure easier to read.

### SIMPLE WORKFLOW



### MANUAL WAVE LABELING

Axiom Draw does not automatically count Elliott waves or decide where each wave begins or ends. The labels help you organize the structure you identify yourself.



### TIP

Use consistent colors and thickness so your wave labels and structure remain clear and easy to follow.

# MEASURE, THICKNESS & COLORS

## Control What You See on the Chart

Measure movement, choose line weight, and apply colors that make your analysis easier to read.



### 01 · Measure Movement

Use Measure to evaluate distance, movement and time directly on the chart.

The Measure tool can show price movement, percentage change, number of bars, time duration and the start-to-end price range.

#### Points & Percentage

▲ +267 pts | +0.23%

#### Bars & Time Duration

25 bars | 1d 1h

#### Start to End Price

1.15402 → 1.15669

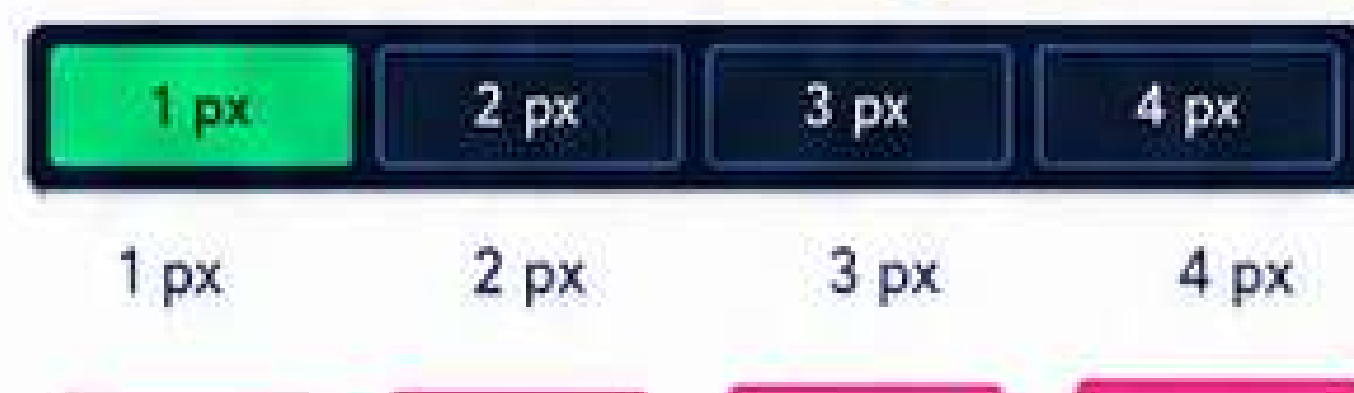
#### Measurement Line

Magenta dashed line shows the measured distance on the chart.

#### Start Point

Beginning of the measurement.

### 02 · Choose Line Weight



Use thinner lines for light references and thicker lines for important structure or emphasis.

### 03 · Solid Colors



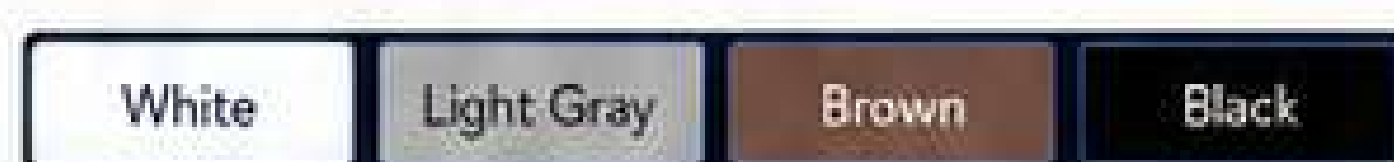
Use solid colors for strong lines, labels, arrows and important visual markings.

### 04 · Transparent Colors



Use transparent colors to highlight zones while keeping candles and price action visible underneath.

### 05 · Neutral Colors



Use neutral colors for subtle references, dark chart contrast or cleaner visual organization.

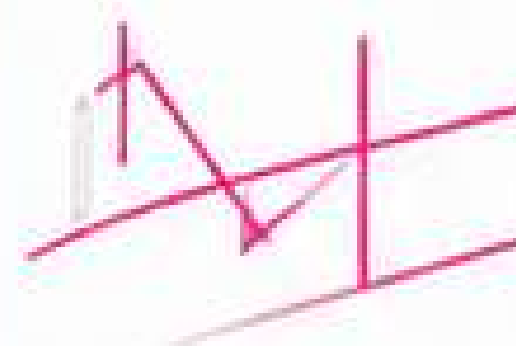
### Active Style

The selected tool, thickness and color are highlighted in the panel so you can see what will be used for your next drawing.

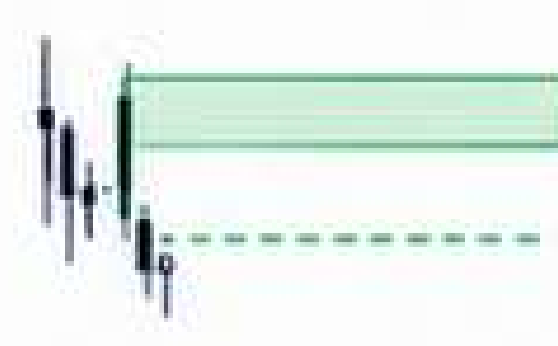


### Style Before You Draw

Choose the thickness and color before placing a drawing when you want the next object to use that style. You can use consistent colors to keep your chart organized.



Magenta for structure



Green for active zones



Yellow/Orange for attention



Gray for secondary references

Measure · 1 px · 2 px · 3 px · 4 px · Solid Colors · Transparent Colors

Use style choices to make your chart analysis cleaner and easier to read.

# EDIT, SELECT & CLEAN

## Keep Your Chart Workspace Under Control

Use Chart mode, Undo, Eraser and Delete All to manage your drawings and keep your analysis clean.

**Chart**  
Return to normal chart interaction.

**Undo**  
Remove the most recent drawing you placed.

**Eraser**  
Remove one drawing at a time.

**Delete All**  
Remove all Axiom Draw drawings from the chart scene.

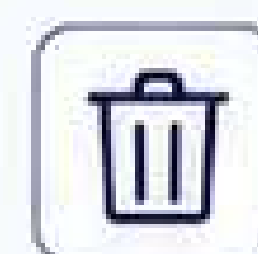
### CLEANUP WORKFLOW



**1** Made a small mistake?  
Use Undo.



**2** Need to remove one object?  
Use Eraser.



**3** Want a clean workspace?  
Use Delete All.

#### 01 Chart Mode



Use Chart to return to normal chart interaction after drawing.

This is the mode to use when you want to stop placing new objects and work with the chart normally.

#### 02 Undo



Use Undo to remove the most recent Axiom Draw object you placed.

This is the fastest way to step back after a recent drawing action.

#### 03 Eraser



Use Eraser when you want to remove one drawing at a time.

Select Eraser, then click the object you want to remove.

#### 04 Delete All



Use Delete All to remove all Axiom Draw drawings from the current chart scene.

Use this when you want to clear the workspace and start fresh.

#### 05 Select & Move Objects

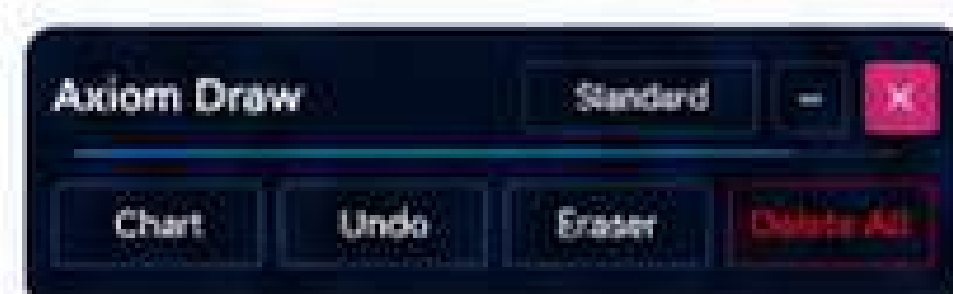


When you are in Chart mode, you can return to normal chart interaction and work with supported drawings on the chart.

Use this when you want to review, select or reposition objects after placing them.

#### 06 Collapsed Toolbar

Minimize the panel when you want more chart space while keeping quick tools close.

#### Move the Panel



Place the Axiom Draw panel where it fits your workspace best, so it does not cover important chart areas.

#### QUICK SHORTCUTS



Minimize / Expand panel



Switch panel layout mode



#### CLEAN ONLY WHAT YOU MEAN TO CLEAN

Undo, Eraser and Delete All are designed to help manage Axiom Draw objects. Use Delete All only when you want to clear the Axiom Draw drawings from the current chart scene.

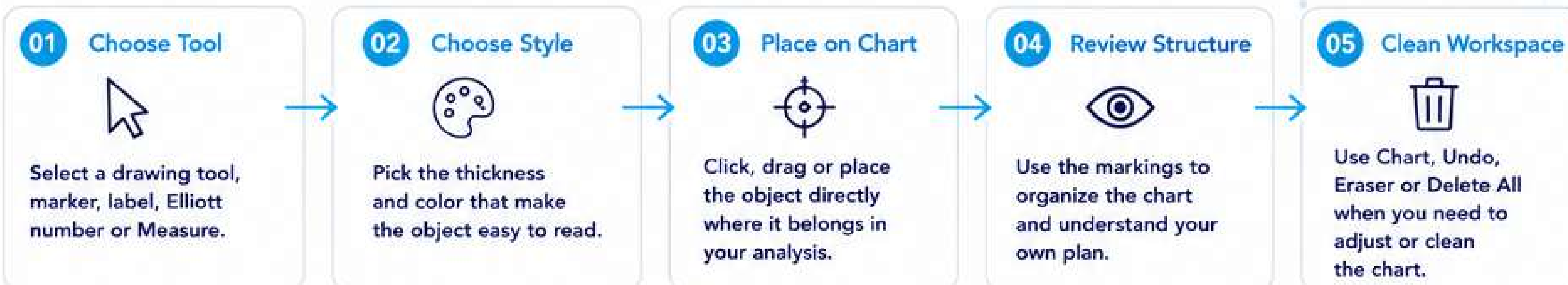

### 01 DRAWING TOOLS



Trend Line · H. Line · Filled Box · Rectangle · Arrow Line · Pencil · Text

Build structure, zones, arrows, freehand notes and written explanations.

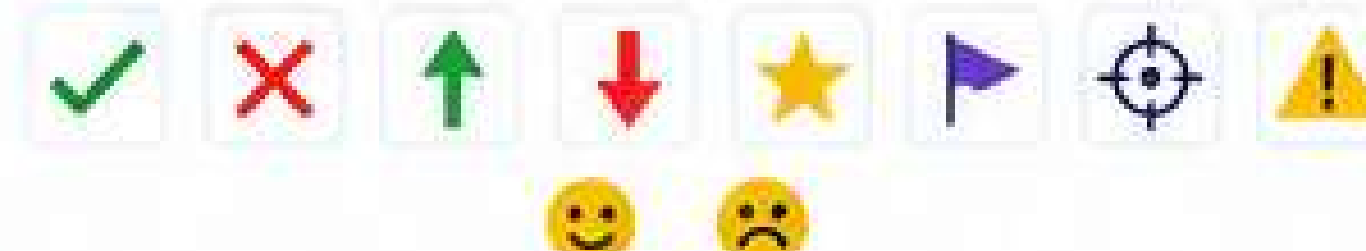
### 02 MEASURE & STYLE



Measure · 1 px · 2 px · 3 px · 4 px · Solid Colors · Transparent Colors

Measure movement and control how strong or subtle each drawing appears.

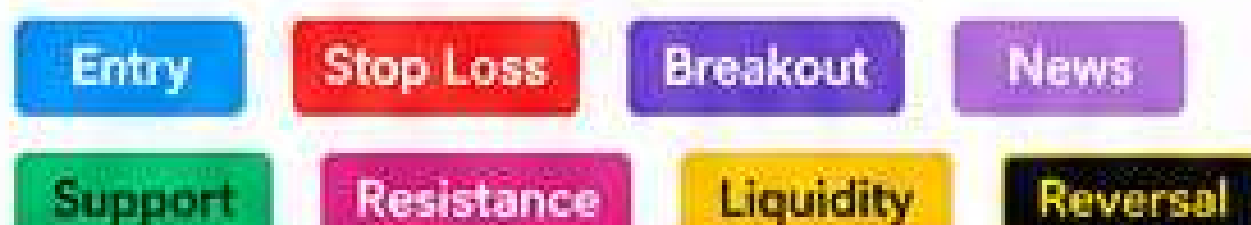
### 03 MARKERS & SYMBOLS



Check · Cross · Up · Down · Star · Flag · Target · Warning · Happy · Sad

Highlight confirmations, warnings, reactions, targets or personal observations.

### 04 TRADING LABELS



Entry · Stop Loss · Breakout · News · Support · Resistance · Liquidity · Reversal

Mark your own trade context and important areas on the chart.

### 05 ELLIOTT LABELS



Elliott 0 · Elliott 1 · Elliott 2 · Elliott 3 · Elliott 4 · Elliott 5 · Elliott 6 · Elliott 7 · Elliott 8 · Elliott 9

Number wave counts or any chart sequence you identify manually.

### 06 EDITING & CLEANUP



Chart · Undo · Eraser · Delete All · Collapse Toolbar · Move Panel

Return to normal chart interaction, remove mistakes and keep the workspace clean.



### REMEMBER THE CORE IDEA

Axiom Draw is a manual visual-analysis workspace. It gives you the tools to draw, mark, measure, label and organize the chart — you decide what the chart means.



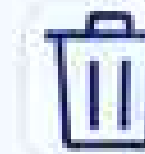
#### Keep It Clean

Use only the markings that help your analysis.



#### Use Consistent Colors

Keep similar ideas in similar colors so the chart is easier to read.



#### Review Before Cleaning

Use Undo or Eraser for small corrections, and Delete All only when you want to clear Axiom Draw drawings from the chart scene.
